Leaving Sullivan Rd (Yorktown Car Park) at 0815 we travel to the Kent Mining Museum, set in Betteshanger Country Park, a former colliery and now 250 acres of woodland, lakes and panoramic views. Step into the fascinating world of the Kent coalfield with two fully accessible floors packed with history of the miners and their communities. Rejoining the coach for the short journey to Deal Castle at 1.30 Please find lunch in Deal town.

This Tudor artillery fortress built for Henry VIII with a revolutionary concentric design, combining a central keep with twelve semi-circular bastions arranged in a Tudor rose pattern allowing 365-degree field of fire. Although there is no catering at the castle, Deal town centre is a few minutes' walk away. We are booked to enter the castle at 2.30 and leave at 4.45 for the return journey to Camberley.
