SIMPLE EXPLANATION OF VIRTUAL GROUPS OR VIDEO CHATTING



We are all familiar with the process of an ordinary telephone call. It entails one person calling up another person and then speaking with each other.



As most of us are aware there is a facility called a ‘tele-conference’ where instead of a telephone call being between two people, several people can be connected to each other and have a telephone chat.

Hypothetically, if we were to add a little TV screen to our telephones, we could then also see the person we are talking to.

Today, we can substitute a computer to replace the telephone and the internet to replace the telephone line.



Using available programs we can connect two or more people who are able to talk to each other and also see each other for the duration of the ‘meeting’.

To put your mind at rest about the simplicity of this approach, some initial trials that we have done confirm that once the initial ‘set up’ has been done (with the help of our support team) joining meetings thereafter is ***no more difficult than answering the telephone !!***

This is the closest you can get to being in the same room with someone, without being in the same room as someone !
