Leaving Camberley, coach travels to Aylesbury, Bucks to visit Waddesdon Manor. A French Renaissance-style chateau with sweeping landscapes and manicured gardens. developed in 1870s/1880s for Baron Ferdinand e Rothschild for his collection of decorative arts.

The Rothschild Foundation, manages Waddesdon on behalf of the National Trust, is expanding the collections of modern and contemporary art visible across the estate. You can explore diverse moods of the garden and working Aviary.

We have entry to the Manor from 12noon (guided tours operate 11.00-12.00noon). The ground floor has step-free access. Second floor requires the lift. Staff members will provide assistance.
